

Ordinance Pertaining to the Adoption of District's Rates and Fees

ORDINANCE NO: 2025-01

AN ORDINANCE OF COLLEGE MOUND SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT, KAUFMAN COUNTY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF DISTRICT'S FEE

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "Commission") requires retail public utilities to adopt a tariff or schedule containing all rates, charges and rules for service stated separately by type of service and customer class;

WHEREAS, TEXAS WATER CODE 65.205 authorizes the College Mound Special Utility District (the "District") to adopt and enforce reasonable rules to, among other things, prevent waste or the unauthorized use of water controlled by the District and to provide for and regulate a safe and adequate water Distribution system;

WHEREAS, TEXAS WATER CODE 49.212 authorizes the District to adopt and enforce all necessary charges and mandatory fees for providing service or making service available;

WHEREAS, TEXAS WATER CODE 49.004 authorizes the Board of Directors to set reasonable civil penalties for the breach of any rule of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that the District Service Policy Contains rates, charges and rules of service by the District in accordance with the Texas Water Code and Commission requirements, and that the adoption of the District Service Policy is in the best interest of the District and its customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF COLLEGE MOUND SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ENGINEERING FEASIBILITY STUDY FEES shall increase according to fees charged by Engineer (Section G(2)(c); and

SECTION 2. ENGINEERING FEASIBILITY STUDY FEES shall not include cost estimates of the project (Section G(2)(c); and

SECTION 3. DISTRICT SHALL IMPLEMENT the increase effective February 1, 2025.
